

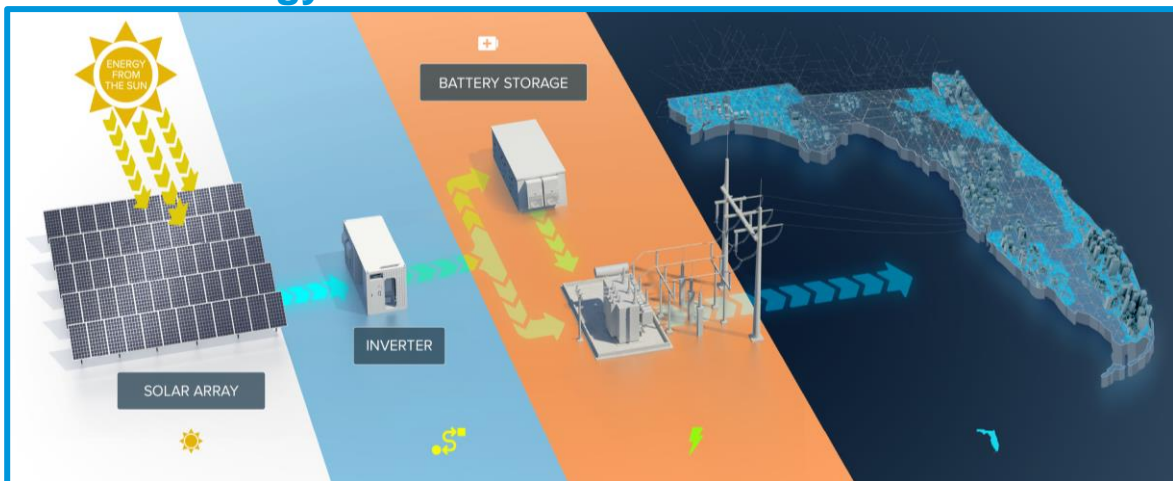

How a Solar Energy Center Works



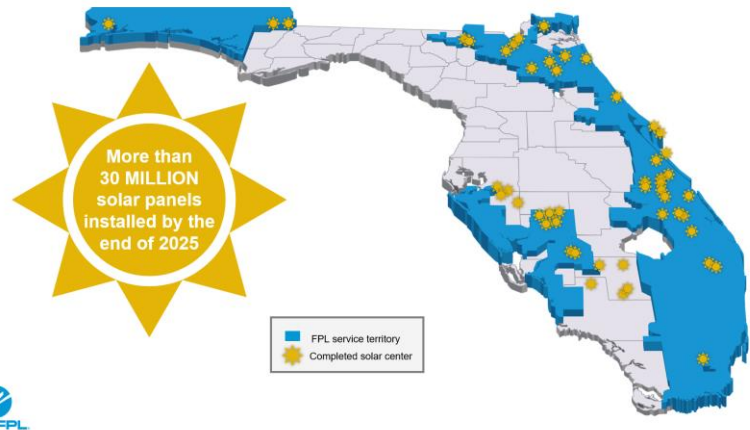
Community Solar

FPL SolarTogether is the largest community solar program in the country. It gives all FPL customers the opportunity to enjoy the benefits of solar no matter where they live, or whether they rent or own their home or business. For a low monthly charge, customers receive the benefits of their portion of the solar energy generated at our solar energy centers in the form of monthly credits on their FPL bill. Over time, credits increase and lower the program participants' bills.



Florida's Energy Landscape is Bright

Florida Power & Light Company offers America's best energy value with the cleanest, most reliable energy at a price that's one of the lowest in the country. The company expects to install 30 million solar panels across the state of Florida before the end of 2025, which would save FPL customers approximately \$2.5 billion in fuel costs.



FPL's Commitment to Charlotte County



The FPL Babcock Ranch Solar Energy Center in Punta Gorda started operations in 2016 and was FPL's first in Charlotte County. It was joined by the FPL Babcock Preserve Solar Energy Center in 2020. Together, FPL has more than 600,000 solar panels in Charlotte County.



Babcock Ranch is a showcase for energy innovation. The FPL solar energy centers on site power thousands of residents when the sun is shining, and even longer, thanks to state-of-the-art battery storage. Solar trees, rooftop solar panels and solar canopies at Founder's Square generate more clean energy for the community and are icons for the town's commitment to sustainability.



FPL SolarNow trees and canopies are innovative solar structures that provide shade and harness the power of the sun while generating emissions-free energy that benefits everyone. Charlotte County is home to nine FPL SolarNow installations that teach the community about clean energy: Ann & Chuck Dever Regional Park, Babcock Ranch, Bailey Brothers Park, Charlotte Sports Park, Charlotte Technical College, Hector House Plaza, Laishley Park, Punta Gorda City Hall and William R. Gaines Jr. Veterans Memorial Park.
